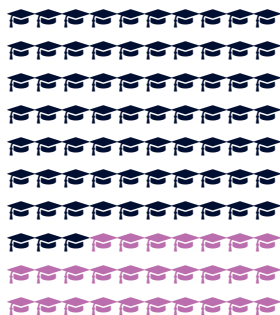


HIGHLY SPECIALIZED/ TALENTED WORKFORCE
