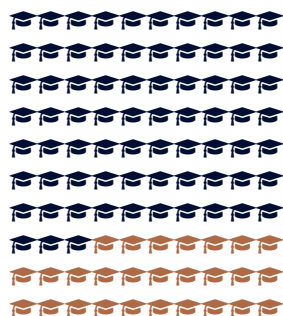

Mississauga is home to the largest municipally owned fibre optic network in Canada

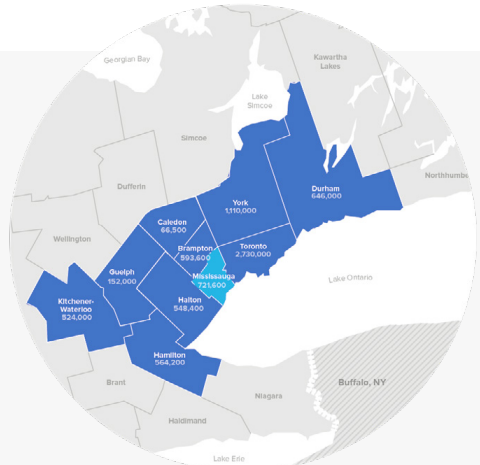


Access to Major Markets

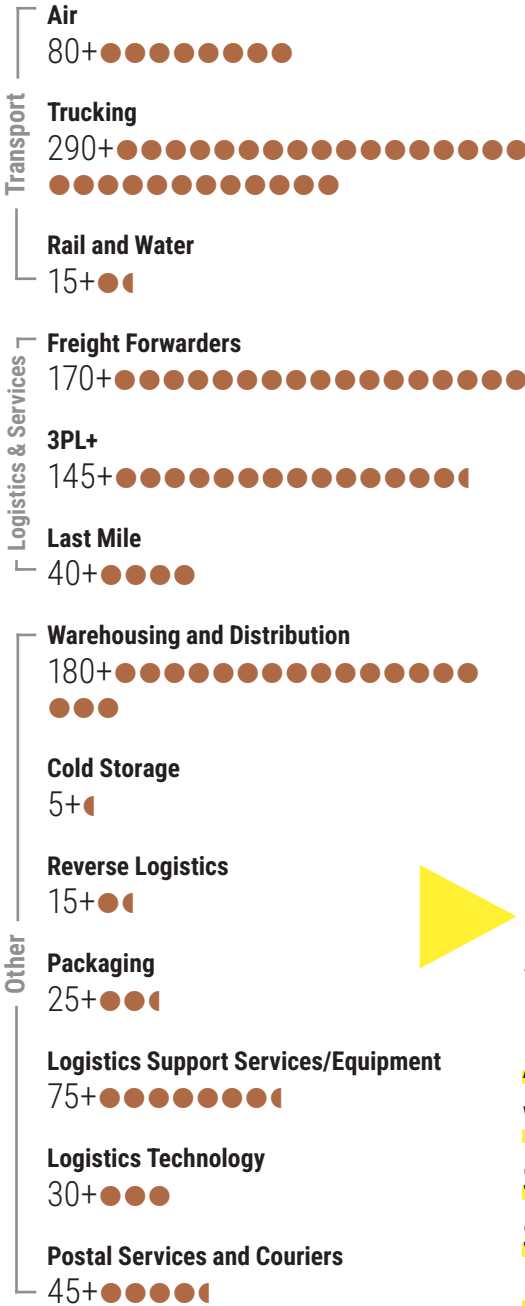
Mississauga is home to Canada's largest airport, serviced by 3 major railway lines and 7 major highways offering fast, convenient access to Canada and USA

HOME TO CANADA'S LARGEST AIRPORT

Pearson Airport
(YYZ) is located in Mississauga

3rd most internationally connected airport in North America

\$46.4 Billion of goods were imported through Pearson's port of entry via air

Largest 90 minute flight catchment area in North America with access to over 200 million people

12+ cargo airlines serving over 180 destinations globally and over 50 million passengers annually

40%+ of Canada's air cargo processed (500,000 metric tonnes annually)

5 runways able to handle all aircraft types and 24/7 customs clearance

1.2 Million sq ft of airport warehouse space, capable of processing 1 million metric tonnes of cargo annually
