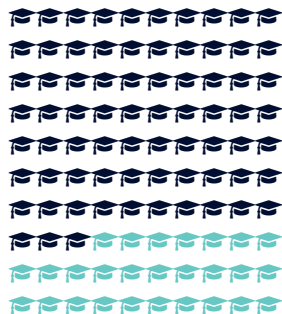

As part of the Toronto Region, Mississauga consistently ranks in the Top 5 global tech talent markets

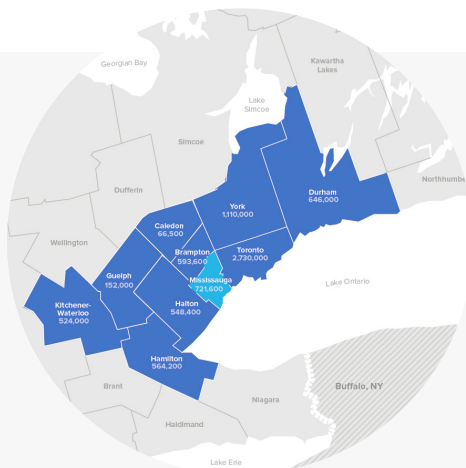


Tech Talent Growth

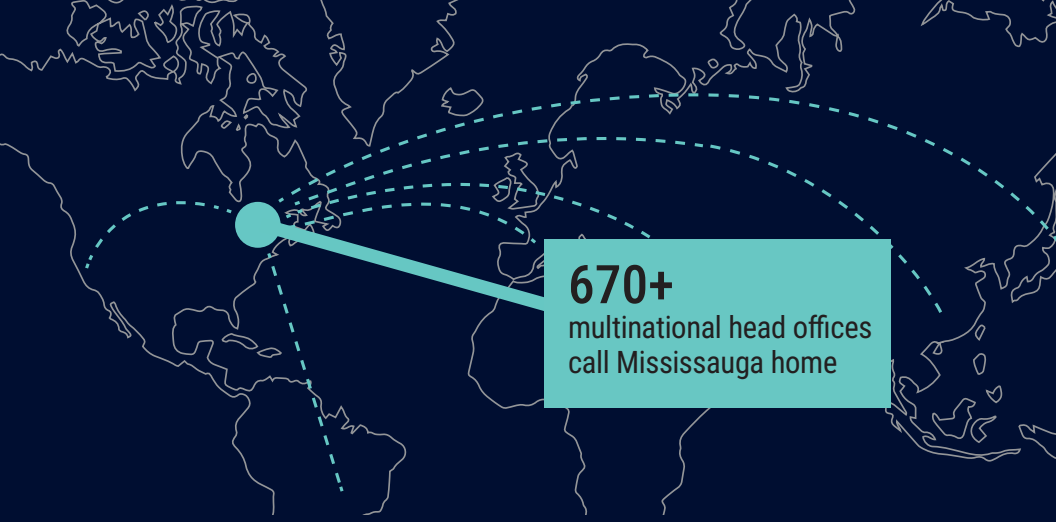
